

# Finding Journals and Newspapers

## Locating journals and newspapers via the Online Catalog

Use the *online catalog*, to locate any journal or newspaper whether electronic, in print, or on microfilm. Locate the online catalog from the library home page <http://library.pittstate.edu/> . Click online catalog.

On the opening screen of the catalog, *click on Periodicals*, located on the blue bar at the top of the page. Enter the first words of the title of the journal.

The results screen will show titles that are in print as well those that are electronic.

Click on the title of the journal to see the complete record. The complete records will show the holdings in Axe Library and provide the link to the electronic text.

For electronic journals, the years covered will be indicated in the link.

For the print journal, to find the years covered, check the “Copy/Holding Information” at the bottom of the record. The journals are either on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor periodical display shelves, on microfilm or in the bound volumes.

## Locating journals and newspapers via Serials Solutions

*Serials Solutions* manages the electronic journals found in databases as well as the print journals found in Axe Library. It can be search as a separate database. Use the link on the homepage under the heading “Other Resources”.

Search by first words of the title or title keyword to locate a listing of titles. Link to the Online Catalog to locate items in Axe Library. Link to the Electronic Database to locate the journal online. The years available online are listed in front of the database name. Tips on finding journals in the databases are found on the Serials Solutions page.

## Locating journals and newspapers by subject

*Serials Solutions* also groups journals by broad subject. Under the heading “Search for journals by subject”, use the drop down box to locate a category. Click on “Search”.

A narrower list of subjects and sub-headings appears indicating the number of journals in each subject in parentheses.
