

# Finding Newspaper Articles

**Begin** by going to the Axe Library homepage: <http://library.pittstate.edu/>

**Locate** the heading “Find Articles and more...”

**Click on** “Databases by Subject”, then **click on** "Starting Point".

## The *Starting Point* databases

- Cover all topics (art through zoology)

- Contain many full text articles

- Link to the Axe Online Catalog for holdings that are not full text

- Allow for emailing, saving, or printing

- Can be used off campus

*Use the following databases for good newspaper coverage. All are full text*

### **LexisNexis Academic Universe**

- Contains full text of over 450 U.S. newspapers

- Includes full text of many international newspapers

- Includes over radio and television news transcripts

- Includes specialized news sources.

- Coverage is from the 1980s.

### **Custom Newspapers**

- Contains full text of 100 U.S. newspapers

- Includes 60 international newspapers

- Coverage is from 1999 to current date
