CINAHL PLUS With Full Text

CINAHL, that favorite old standard of students of nursing, medicine, health care, psychology, allied health and biology has undergone a makeover. In addition to journal articles, it now delivers many other kinds of documents in full text. Here is a list of only a few:

Books and Book Chapters

Care Plans

CEUs

Exam Questions

Masters' Theses

Pamphlets

Questionnaires/Scales

Research Instruments (Tests)

To locate materials in CINAHL, go to the library home page (<http://library.pittstate.edu/>) and click on [Databases by Title](#). [CINAHL Plus with Full Text](#) is under "C". You can also find it by clicking [Databases by Subject](#). Then choose "Nursing and Health" and click on [CINAHL Plus with Full Text](#).

Next, you will want to type your search terms in the search box at the top of the page:

Lyme disease

If you want to limit your search to a certain aspect of the topic, in the next box you can add, for example,

Therapy

Some items will be full text. These you can print by clicking the "**print**" icon, e-mail to yourself by clicking the "**e-mail**" icon or save by clicking the "**disc**" icon.

Article Linker

If some of the journal articles you want are not full text, you may be able to retrieve them from other databases using *Article Linker*. Just click the *Article Linker* icon under the citation and it will tell you:

1. If we have the item in our library collection
2. If the item can be retrieved full text from another database; or
3. If you need to make use of Interlibrary Loan.

Limiting

Sometimes, you may want to limit the type of material you retrieve. Look at the opening search screen. Under “Limiting Your Search” you will see two columns listing a number of ways to limit your search. Four of the favorites are:

Full Text (left side): Provides the entire article or other publication.

Research Article (left side): An article in a scholarly journal which does a scientific study of a specific population. (e.g.: [Risk factor for methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus \(MRSA\) infection in institutions for the elderly during the winter months](#))

Peer Reviewed (right side): Any article in a scholarly journal, but not necessarily a research article.

Publication Type (right side): Where you can limit your search to Care Plans, Case Studies, CEUs, Editorials, Exam Questions, etc.

If you wish to use CINAHL at home

Go to the Library homepage. However, after you click on the title of the database, you will be asked for your PSU ID number and your GUS PIN/Password. After filling them in, you should get in without any trouble. If you have any problems, call reference at 235-4894.

Interlibrary Loan/Document Delivery

For items not owned by Axe Library or not available from other databases, you may use Interlibrary Loan.

From the *Article Linker* page, click on “Request on Interlibrary Loan”. This will bring you to the **Axe ILLiad** log on page. If you are a first-time user, you must register to become part of the ILLiad system. Most items you order are free of charge. The Interlibrary Loan department will tell you in advance if it costs anything



You may also request articles owned by Axe Library through the *Document Delivery* service. If a requested journal article is not available online, but owned by Axe Library, it will be scanned and uploaded to your ILLiad account. Simply click on “Request on Interlibrary Loan” and login. There is no charge for the *Document Delivery* service.

. Log in to your account. On the left-hand side, click on the word “Photocopy” and fill in the form. For books and films, under

click on

[WorldCat](#)

. After finding the item, click on the line  [Request via ILLiad](#) and fill in your PSU ID number and GUSPIN/Password. Photocopied articles begin to arrive in your account in just a few days. Books begin to arrive in about a week, but it is important to begin requesting early. Almost all these materials can be borrowed free of charge.
