You should now be seeing a list of databases that will allow you to access dissertations & theses on-line or by Inter-Library loan.

Near the end of the list you will see the heading **PSU Theses**. To access the PSU thesis in the catalog you will need to enter "**thesis Pittsburg**" as a **Title Keyword search**. You can limit your search by adding more title keywords (ex. **Thesis Pittsburg Communication**) or by using the "**Power Search**" feature to add subject keywords to the title keyword search terms. These theses are shelved by Dewey call number on the first floor of the library behind the periodicals. The PSU theses may be checked out. A second copy is located in the library archives, but may not be taken from the Archives.

The following flow chart should help you plan your research into theses and dissertations. Most of the sources suggested by the chart are on this list.
