Peer-Reviewed Articles

Peer-reviewed or **refereed** articles (a subset of *Scholarly* or *Academic* articles) tend to be original research and have been approved by several scholars in the field before being published. They usually begin with an *abstract* (a summary of the article) followed by a *literature review* (an overview of similar research articles) and a description of the *methodology* used. Then, the research is described including hypothesis and results, frequently with many charts or graphs. Since peer-reviewed articles go through a review process, they have the reputation of being of the highest quality.

Many of our databases have easy access to peer-reviewed articles. To find peer-reviewed articles, go to a Database from the Axe homepage.

Many databases, such as *Academic Search Premier*, *Academic OneFile* and *Research Library*, have a “check box” under the search area or a “tab” that you can use to limit your search. The wording varies, but look for the words “Scholarly,” “Peer-reviewed,” “Academic,” or “Refereed.”
