

ProQuest Nursing & Allied Health Source

ProQuest is a nursing and allied health database indexing 700 titles, over 580 are in full text and many are also peer reviewed. In addition to scholarly peer reviewed journals, ProQuest includes full text nursing dissertations, nursing related newspaper articles, medical and nursing trade publications, and articles from popular magazines and health magazines. The dates it covers are 1986 to the present.

To locate materials in ProQuest, go to the Library home page (<http://library.pittstate.edu/>) and under "Find Articles and More" click on [Databases by Title](#). [ProQuest Nursing & Allied Health Source](#) is under "P.". You can also find it by clicking [Databases by Subject](#). Choose "Nursing" then, click on [ProQuest Nursing & Allied Health Source](#).

Next, type your search terms in the search box at the top of the page:

If you want to limit your search to a certain aspect of the topic, in the next box add another concept, such as

And then click the "Search" button. Some items will be full text. These you can print by clicking the "print" icon, e-mail to yourself by clicking the "e-mail" icon or save by clicking the "disc" icon.

Article Linker

If some of the journal articles you want are not full text, you may be able to retrieve them from other databases. Just click the Article Linker icon under the citation and it will tell you:

1. If we have the item in our library collection
2. If the item can be retrieved full text from another database; or
3. If you need to make use of Interlibrary Loan.



Limiting

Sometimes, you may want to limit the type of material you retrieve. On the “Results” page in the middle of the screen you will see the various tabs for different kinds of sources. If you are only interested in full text, click “Show only full text”. If you want scholarly journals, click “Scholarly Journals”. If you click “Videos” you can watch short films from the Medcom Video Training Programs Collection. **Click on “Dissertations” to find full text online dissertations from all over the United States.**

If you wish to use ProQuest at home

Go to the Library homepage. Locate the “ProQuest Nursing” database. When you click on the database name, you will be asked for your PSU ID number and your GUS PIN/Password. After filling them in, you should get in without any trouble. If you have any problems, call reference at 235-4894.

Interlibrary Loan/Document Delivery

For items not owned by Axe Library or not available from other databases, you may use Interlibrary Loan. On the “Article Linker” screen, click on “Request on Interlibrary Loan”. This will bring you to the **Axe ILLiad** page. If you are a first-time user, you must register to establish your ILLiad account. Most items you order are free of charge. The Interlibrary Loan department will tell you in advance if it costs anything.



You may also request articles owned by Axe Library through the “Document Delivery” service. If a requested article is not online, but owned by Axe Library, it will be scanned and uploaded to your ILLiad account. Simply click on “Request on Interlibrary Loan” and login. There is no charge for the Document Delivery service.

Other Ways to Order Material from Interlibrary Loan

For articles, go to the Axe Home Page (<http://library.pittstate.edu/>) and under **Other Resources** click on **Interlibrary Loan**. Log in to your account. On the left-hand side, click on the word “Photocopy” and fill in the form. For books and films, under **Find Books & More** click on **WorldCat**. After finding the item, click on the line **Request via ILLiad** and fill in your PSU ID number and GUSPIN/Password. Photocopied articles begin to arrive in your account in just a few days. Books begin to arrive in about a week, but it is important to begin requesting early. Almost all these materials can be borrowed free of charge.
