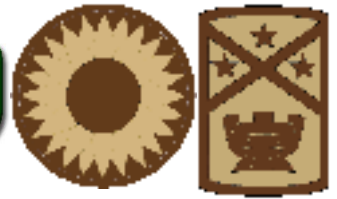

1.) What is the Dust Devil Dispatch?

- *The Dust Devil Dispatch is the official Task Force Dust Devil News Bulletin that serves the service members and their families of the 891st Engineer Combat Battalion, Heavy and A Company, 230th Engineer Battalion while they are deployed to Operation Iraqi Freedom in Iraq. New editions are published weekly on Saturdays.*

4.) How do I print the Dust Devil Dispatch?

- *Issues 1 - 8 are in Adobe (.pdf) format and can be printed as an entire publication (requires 4 pages per issue) All other issues are in website format (.html) and can be printed in two ways, each page can be printed individually by going to that page and selecting FILE > PRINT from the menu bar of your internet browser. If you wish to print every page from the website format, go to the "Featured Article" page of the issue you wish to print, select FILE > PRINT, once the print window opens, select the "OPTIONS" tab at the top of that window. Make sure the "PRINT ALL LINKED DOCUMENTS" box is checked, then press the "PRINT" button. For a step-by-step guide with pictures, [CLICK HERE!](#)*

5.) When I try to view the new issue of the Dust Devil Dispatch, it asks me for a password, what does this mean?

- *Every issue of the Dust Devil Dispatch must be approved by a number of people before being published. To speed-up this process, the new issue is loaded under a password protected area while the issue is being approved, once the issue is approved, the password protection will be removed and you will be able access the new issue.*

- *The Dust Devil Dispatch is composed and published by SPC Jay Gfeller with the help of soldiers and family members of the 891st Engineer Battalion and A Company, 230th Engineer Battalion.*
